- Each presenter will sit at one table and will prepare a 5-10-minute description of their topic. There will be no laptops provided so slides are not necessary nor are handouts (however, if you choose to you may bring both a laptop and handouts)
- Attendees will visit multiple tables during this time and each session will last 15 minutes, so presenters should expect to present their topic about 3 times.

Submission requirements:

Provide a brief description of the program/activity. Please include: 1. Reason the activity was/is needed 2. Description of the activity 3. Impact on the community 4. Lessons learned

- One page no more than 300 words
- Submit with completed attached Presenter Contact Form

Submissions can cover the following topics:

- Description of CHW program
 - o Goals of the program
 - o Need addressed by the program
 - o CHW's Role
 - Roles and responsibilities
 - How does the CHW contribute to improving health outcomes
 - Highlight any successes
 - Describe challenges and solutions to those challenges
 - Program's outcomes/impact on the community
- Participation in policy and advocacy efforts on behalf of community health workforce
 - What was the targeted policy or goal of advocacy
 - o What was your role
 - What was your/your group's strategy or actions taken
 - What was the outcome
 - Highlight successes, challenges, or lessons, learned
- Other topic areas will be accepted as long as they highlight the work of community health and outreach workers. This can be broad or a specific case study.
