Learn how to:

- Assess a breathing or cardiac emergency situation
- Perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) to help save a person's life
- Use an automated external defibrillator (AED) to help someone experiencing cardiac arrest

Knowing the basics of CPR and AED can save someone's life in a cardiac or breathing emergency. In this course, community health workers (CHWs) will learn basic instructions for emergency communications and risk assessment. CHWs who demonstrate CPR and AED correctly will receive a certification valid for two years. There is a \$40 fee to receive a certification wallet card for non-CHW Academy students.
