Community health workers (CHWs) will learn critical emergency preparedness skills for the workplace and field outreach. Being well-prepared is critical, as emergencies may require CHWs to sustain on their own for several days. The course will cover important aspects of emergency preparedness, such as putting together a disaster supplies kit with essential items for dealing with unexpected situations.
